Dear Parent,

Pursuant to the Education Accountability Act of 2009, all public schools in Colorado are required to develop unified improvement plans (UIPs) that outline targets for performance outcomes and strategies that the school will implement to achieve academic improvement. Depending on performance, schools are expected to implement a performance plan, improvement plan, priority improvement plan, turnaround plan. Based on results from the Colorado School Performance Framework in 2017, Jefferson Jr./Sr. High School will be updating its priority improvement plan during the 2017-2018 school year.

The school was assigned to this plan type based on low-performance in the areas of CMAS English Language Arts, Math, and Science Assessments. Attached is the 2017 school performance framework report that describes how the school has been evaluated.

The district must submit Jefferson Jr./Sr. High School's UIP to the Colorado Department of Education on or before January 15, 2018 for review. The UIP provides the school a focused improvement plan, including a data analysis on student performance and a detailed action plan. To meet that deadline, the UIP will be developed according to the following timeline: *the goal is to finish the UIP by October 6th.*

The School Accountability Committee will hold a public meeting to gather input from parents concerning the development of the plan on 9/29/17 at 8:30am, in the main conference room.
